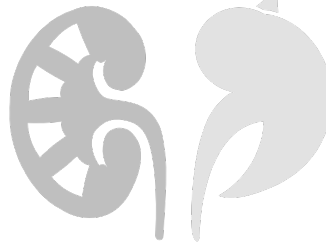
NephJC is an online journal club that meets on Twitter. We do two articles every month and discuss each article twice:
